Rosmah visits malnourished teenage boy

SEREMBAN: Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, wife of the prime minister, yesterday visited the malnourished teenage boy who was found in a state of neglect, at the Tuanku Ja'afar Hospital here.

The boy, Muhammad Firdaus Dullah, 15, was found at a unit of the Taman Semarak flats in Nilai on June 21. He was found in an emaciated condition and covered in his own faeces by the Negri Sembilan Director of Immigration Faizal Fazri Othman when the department conducted a joint operation at the flat.

Rosmah spent about 30 minutes with Firdaus before giving him a pair of blue 'baju Melayu' and a songkok as well as a hamper of fruits.

"I was informed by the director of the hospital, Datuk Dr Jaafar Che Mat, that Muhammad Firdaus was eating and sleeping well, and that his weight had increased by 2.3kg."

She said that members of the public who wanted to contribute to Muhammad Firdaus could do so through his Tabung Haji account (No. 010602000453616). - Bernama
