## Tabung Haji Board hands over 2012 tithe

**KOTA KINABALU:** The Tabung Haji Board handed over a total of RM848,899.59 of business tithe to the Sabah Tithe Centre yesterday.

Its senior general manager (Property and Administration Management), Abdul Halim Md Jamil, handed over the tithe to Islamic Religious Council of Sabah (MUIS) chairman Datuk Suhaili Said during a courtesy visit to Head of State Tun Haji Juhar Haji Mahiruddin.

Halim said the Tabung Haji's tithe was part of the institution's profit for the financial year 2012.

He disclosed that the amount of tithe in Sabah for 2012 had increased by nine per cent, compared to only RM781,521 in 2011.

The total amount of Tabung Haji business tithe for the year 2012, which will be paid to the states nationwide, is RM41.2 million.

"Sabah is the second state to receive Tabung Haji tithe payment, which will be followed by Sarawak, and other states nationwide," he said.

Also present at the ceremony was MUIS secretary Datuk Haji Amri A Suratman.
