Johor sultan not performing haj

JOHOR BARU: Sultan of Johor Sultan Ibrahim Sultan Iskandar said he will not perform the haj as planned with

The ruler said the rest of his fam-ily, including Permaisuri Johor Raja Zarith Sofiah Sultan Idris Shah and four of their children, would, how-ever, proceed with the pilgrimage and had embarked on their journey

from Johor yesterday.

"After undergoing angioplasty four days ago, my doctors advised me not to perform the haj because it involves long-distance travel and many physical challenges. "My family and their entourage

did not want to go without me, but it and not want to go without me, but it is my wish that they do so. I want the state officials and my staff to perform the haj because they may not get the chance to do so in future,

"As much as I would like to be with them, I accept Allah's wisdom and that He knows best," said Sultan Ibrahim on his Facebook page yes-

terday.
Other members of the royal family Other memoers of the royal animy performing the haj are Tunku Puterl Johor Tunku Tun Aminah, Tunku Temenggong Johor Tunku Idris, Tunku Panglima Johor Tunku Ab-dul Rahman and Tunku Putera Johor Tunku Abu Bakar. Sultan Ibrahim said he and his wife

had performed the haj together in 1985, and after their son, Tunku Laksamana Johor Tunku Abdul Jalil, died last year, the family had planned
