Avoid dubious haj agencies, Sultan tells pilgrims

SHAH ALAM — The Sultan of Selangor, Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, reminded would-be pilgrims in the state yesterday to avoid dealing with haj agencies with questionable status. He said this was to avoid being overwhelmed with problems related to travelling whether in Malaysia or Saudi Arabia. Sultan Sharafuddin also urged pilgrims to uphold good morals, behaviour and high character during the haj season. He said they must make adequate preparations before going to the Holy Land as it required high physical health and mental strength.
