# Five organisations hand over business tithe to King

**ALOR SETAR:** The Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Tuanku Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah, yesterday received business tithe for 2013 amounting to RM16.635 million from five organisations for the Kedah Zakat Department (JZNK) and the Federal Territory Zakat Collection Centre (PPZ).

His Majesty received RM13.393 million for JZNK from the Pilgrims Management and Fund Board (Tabung Haji), Permodalan Nasional Berhad (PNB), Bank Persatuan, Bank Rakyat and Angkatan Koperasi Kebangsaan Malaysia Berhad (Angkasa) at a ceremony held at the Istana Anak Bukit here.

The king also received RM3.24 million for PPZ from Bank Rakyat and Angkasa.

Chief Executive Tan Sri Hamad Kama Piah Che Othman handed over a cheque for RM7.779 million from the organisation.

Tabung Haji Group Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer Datuk Ismee Ismail handed over a cheque for RM3.46 million while Bank Persatuan President Datuk Yusra Sabar handed over a cheque for RM150,000.

A member of Bank Rakyat's Board of Directors, Datuk Mangsor Saad, handed over a cheque for RM1.94 million for JZNK and another for RM3.17 million for PPZ while Angkasa President Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah handed over a cheque for RM57,341 for JZNK and another for RM69,205 for PPZ. - Bernama
