Nasir happy with Tabung Haji services

MECCA: Minister in the Chief Minister's Department, Datuk Haji Nasir Tun Sakaran expressed satisfaction with the services provided by Tabung Haji Malaysia in handling Malaysians performing the Haj and Umrah here.
