BACK FROM PILGRIMAGE: A haj pilgrim waiting for his bag at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) yesterday. The first batch of 442 Malaysian haj pilgrims arrived at KLIA yesterday via Saudi Airlines flight SV5644. Their arrival at 11.21am from the King Abdul Aziz International Airport, Jeddah, was greeted by Tabung Haji (TH) deputy CEO Datuk Badlisyah Abdul Ghani, top TH management officers as well as family members and relatives who waited at KLIA since 10am. A total of 47 flights will be bringing home all 22,320 Malaysian pilgrims beginning yesterday, with the last flight scheduled to arrive in the country on Oct 15. — *Bernama*
