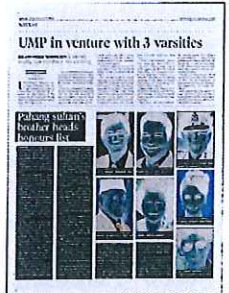

Pahang sultan's brother heads honours list

KUANTAN: Datuk Tengku Idris Sultan Abu Bakar heads the state honours' list in conjunction with the 83rd birthday of the Sultan of Pahang, Sultan Ahmad Shah, today.

Tengku Idris, who is the sultan's younger brother, will receive the Sri Sultan Ahmad Shah Pahang (SSAP) award, which carries the title "Datuk Seri".

Other SSAP recipients are Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Tan Sri Joseph Kurup, Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Rohani Abdul Karim, Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Minister Datuk Hasan Malek, Human Resources Minister Datuk Richard Riot Jaem;

Federal Court judge Datin Paduka Zaleha Zahari, Federal Territories and Urban Wellbeing Ministry secretary-general Datuk Adnan Md Ikhsan, Immigration Department director-general Datuk Alias Ahmad, Solicitor-General Datuk Idrus Harun;

Kuantan Umno division deputy chief Datuk Abdul Hamid Mohd Nazahar, Felda Foundation chief executive officer Datuk Dr Emel Faizal Mohd Mokhtar, Tabung Haji chief operating officer Datuk Kamarudin Mat Ali and Kelantan Solid Waste Management and Public Cleansing director Datuk Afandi Hamzah.

Also on the list are Bukit Aman Commercial Crime Investigation Department director Datuk Syed Ismail Syed Azizan and Bukit Aman Management Department director Datuk Mortadza Nazarene.

Pahang Works Department director Datuk Ir Rosman Yahya leads another group of five who will receive the Sri Sultan Ahmad Shah Pahang (SIMP) award, which carries the title "Datuk".

State Development director Datuk Dzul-kifly Osman, Bursa Malaysia chief executive officer Datuk Tajuddin Atan, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia Heart and Lung Centre head Professor Datuk Dr Mohd Rainzisham Abdul Rahman and Universiti Kuala Lumpur chairman

and pro-chancellor Datuk Dr Adham Baba are also recipients of SIMP.

The Sri Sultan Ahmad Shah Pahang (DSAP) award, which carries the title "Datuk", will be conferred on 13 recipients.

Singer Jamal Abdillah, whose real name is Jamal Ubaidillah Ali, and Indonesian songstress Rossa, or Sri Rossa Roslaini Handiyani, are among 90 recipients of the Darjah Indera Mahkota Pahang (DIMP), which carries the title Datuk.

Other recipients include state Health and Human Resources Committee chairman Norol Azali Sulaiman, state Religious Affairs Committee chairman Syed Ibrahim Syed Ahmad and assemblymen Mohd Shohaimi Jusoh (Lepar), Mohd Fadil Osman (Kemayan), Wan Salman Wan Ismail (Jengka) and Khairuddin Mahmud (Pulau Manis).

The list also includes 34 recipients of the Setia Ahmad Shah Pahang, 41 for Setia Mahkota Pahang, 49 for Ahli Ahmad Shah Pahang, 146 for Ahli Mahkota Pahang, 55 for Pingat Khidmat Cemerlang, 107 for Pingat Kelakuan Terpuji and 87 for Pingat Jasa Kebaktian awards.

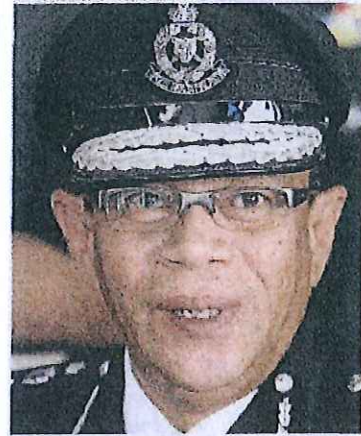
