

'Express haj' trial set for April

KUALA LUMPUR: The Sessions Court here yesterday fixed three days, beginning April 25, for the hearing of the "express haj" case involving two Tabung Haji officers.

Clerk Roslan Mohamad Som, 47, attached to the Haj Research and Development Division, was charged with accepting a RM6,750 bribe from a middleman, Samsudin Ibrahim, in Kampung Baru, Jalan Raja Muda Musa, here, between 3.30pm and 4pm on July 15, 2010.

Systems analyst Afizul Md Yasin, 34, was charged with three counts of authorising the modification in the haj system database.
