# Naim holds Labour Day celebration

*Naim to complete hall project on time, allocates RM50 million for Bumi and human resource development.*

**KUCHING:** Naim Sunday assured that the Multi-purpose Hall at the new Kompleks Islam at Jalan P Ramlee will be handed over to Tabung Baitulmal Sarawak in time for the National Level Majlis Tadarus Al-Quran to be held soon.

This assurance was given by Naim CEO cum Managing Director, Datuk Hasmi Hasnan when delivering his speech at the Naim Labour Day Celebration held at the Kompleks Islam at which Tuan Haji Abg Mohd Shibli bin Haji Abg. Mohd Nailie the General Manager of Tabung Baitulmal Sarawak was the Guest of Honour.

He informed the gathering that Naim is in the midst of going through a corporate transformation plan (CTP) and for this purpose he has formed a team to conduct a study on the CTP.

According to Datuk Hasmi, the Company has put aside RM50 million for human resource development, and this includes staff train-

ing, rewards, incentives (including ESOS) and various other human resource development programs in the coming years as part of their CTP.

Part of the allocation will be for a Bumiputera Development Program. As a responsible Bumiputera Company which is substantially institutionally owned and whose shareholders include Permodalan Nasional Berhad (PNB), EPF and Tabung Haji and being one of the biggest Bumiputera companies in Malaysia (if not the biggest), they intend to develop their Bumiputera sub-contractors and suppliers to turn them into becoming the best contractors and vendors in Sarawak, if not Malaysia.

He also said that Naim has commissioned a local university to study into the success or failures

of Bumiputera entrepreneurs and should be getting their findings soon.

To-date, Naim had completed almost RM4.4 billion worth of work, all delivered on time within specification and budget. This includes the more than 15,000 units of residential, commercial and industrial properties built throughout Sarawak, benefiting the more than 60,000 people who occupy those premises and employment to the thousands through the spin-off effects of its operations.

To commemorate the celebration Tuan Haji Abg Mohd Shibli and Datuk Hasmi planted a tree each.
